Project Context:

Old Diorama Arts Centre has been awarded funding to deliver, alongside Sankofa Storytelling Arts, a **three-day performing and expressive arts holiday club for children aged between 5 - 10 years old**. This festive experience will explore six global, cultural festivals that are celebrated during December.

We will create a range of create-your-own festive comics and celebrations cards by combining three action packed days of: drama, dance, crafts and through the discovery of global cuisines. The six different cultural festivals will be explored through the vehicle of participatory storytelling at the beginning of each day by the Drama Lead. You will then lead/assist your own sub-group.

A hot lunch is provided on each day, plus snacks, (this is a holiday club primarily for recipients of Free School Meals).

We are seeking experienced Lead Drama and/or Dance Facilitators and Assistant Facilitators. Your exciting approach to designing, leading and monitoring your workshops will ensure that all children, including including those with Special Educational Needs, have a truly positive experience.

Your role will also include monitoring and supervising Arts & Crafts activities.
